1. This letter provides information on civilian occupational injury and illness experience within U.S. Navy for the second quarter of FY00. Enclosure (1) contains summary statistical data and charts for major Echelon 2 commands and large industrial activities. Specific case listings upon which the charts in enclosure (1) are based come from the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP) database as provided to the Naval Safety Center.

2. The frequency rate for all U.S. Navy civilian occupational injury and illness cases filed with the OWCP for the second quarter of FY00 is 4.27 cases per 100 work years. This rate is 32 percent below our FY90 baseline year total case frequency rate. Our frequency rate for lost time cases is 2.21 which is 42 percent below the level of FY90.

3. Your attention, support and efforts at maintaining effective occupational safety and health programs, and in preventing injuries and illnesses on the job is greatly appreciated and essential to future injury cost control.

**MAJOR COMMAND AND INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY CIVILIAN
OCCUPATIONAL INJURY AND ILLNESS CASE EXPERIENCE
FOR SECOND QUARTER OF FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2000**

This enclosure provides injury and illness case numbers and rates for major commands, shipyards, aviation depots, and public works centers for FY 2000.

The case rate data is summarized from the Office of Workers' Compensation Programs (OWCP), Federal Employees Compensation Act (FECA), Table #2 Reports. Case rates are calculated from full-time United States civilian (permanent and temporary) workforce end strength (population) using the following formula:

$$\text{Case Rate} = \frac{\text{Cases} \times 200,000 \text{ hours worked}^*}{\text{End Strength} \times 500 \text{ hours} \times (n) \text{ Quarters}}$$

*200,000 work hours = 100 employees X 50 weeks X 40 hours/week

Note: The summary tables in TAB (A) through TAB (D) use FY 1990 as the baseline year. The data in the case rate tables is based on accumulative case experience for fiscal year and average employment levels for the fiscal year to date. The case rate charts in TABS (E) and (F) are based on actual case experience during each quarter and average employment during the quarter.




TOTAL CASE RATE - NAVAIR




TOTAL CASE RATE - NAVFAC







TOTAL CASE RATE - NAVSUP




TOTAL CASE RATE - SPAWAR




TOTAL CASE RATE - BUMED




TOTAL CASE RATE - CNET




TOTAL CASE RATE - NAVRES







TOTAL CASE RATE - LANT




TOTAL CASE RATE - PACFLT





TOTAL CASE RATE - SHIPYARDS




TOTAL CASE RATE - DEPOT'S










NAVAIR LOST TIME CASE RATES











SPAWAR LOST TIME CASE RATES






CINCLANTFLT LOST TIME CASE RATES




CINCPACFLT LOST TIME CASE RATES







CNET LOST TIME CASE RATES





NAVRES LOST TIME CASE RATES
