Speakers Bureau Frequently Asked Questions

How much lead time is required to request a speaker?

Maximum working time usually produces positive results. Try to allow at least three to four weeks. [However, shorter notice speaking engagements can be arranged on a case by case basis. This usually depends on factors such as availability of speakers and geographic location of the event].

Who will be the speaker?

There are a variety of speakers with unique talents and experiences to share. Often admirals attend the large scale events. However, if you are a smaller group, there are talented speakers throughout the ranks. We try to match your event size, location and availability of speakers to your particular request.

What costs are involved?

Normally, the command to which the speaker is assigned must finance the expenses.
